

# Self-Guided Tour FAQ

We're excited to welcome you on a self-guided tour through the Museum! We want everyone to have the best possible experience. **Please review the rules below in advance with your students.** Groups may be asked to end their visit early if these directions are not followed.



Students 18 and under must be supervised by a chaperone. We require one chaperone for every 10 students.



Only pencils are allowed in the galleries. Pens and other writing implements are not permitted.



Backpacks, bulky coats, and umbrellas are not permitted in the galleries.

There are a limited number of bins available from the Welcome Desk for coats and bags if needed.



Non-flash photography is allowed in the galleries and sculpture gardens for personal, non-commercial use, except where noted.



Food and drink are not permitted in the Museum.



Conversation is encouraged, but please be mindful of your volume.



Do not touch artwork or lean on cases containing artwork.



Security officers are here to help. Please listen to any instructions given by security guards in the Museum.



Please walk through the galleries. Running is not permitted.
